What is DUI MAT?

The DUI MAT Integration/Outreach Project (DUI MAT) is one of over 26 projects in the California Mat Expansion Project, State Opioid Response (SOR) I-III, funded through federal and state grants from SAMHSA and DHCS to address the opioid and overdose crises in the State. The project meets the goal of creating new OUD and PolySUD treatment access points through integration with DUI Programs located throughout California.

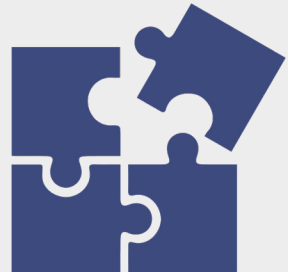
